9:00 – 9:30 am	Beyond the Comorbidity Index: Capturing Predictors that Matter for Survival and Quality of Life after Allogeneic Haematopoietic Stem Cell Transplantation Speaker: Dr Genevieve Douglas, Haematologist and BMT Physician (Austin Hospital) Haematopoietic stem cell transplant remains the only curative treatment for many high-risk blood cancers, including AML and MDS. However, a major barrier to long-term treatment success and survival are HSCT-related comorbidities. Dr Gen Douglas will share how the assessment of pre-HSCT comorbidities can predict transplant outcomes and the importance of ongoing screening for HSCT “late effects” in survivorship.
